Regular Order of Business

Audit Requests Presented

2015-101: California Superintendent of Public Instruction—Inglewood Unified School District: **Senator Hall** requested an audit of the California Superintendent's oversight, monitoring, and administration of the Inglewood Unified School District, which is under receivership.

Assemblymember Ridley-Thomas presented the audit request on behalf of Senator Hall.

*Motion to approve the audit by Achadjian, seconded by Campos: **Passed 12-0** (Assembly 7-0, Senate 5-0)*

2015-108: Irvine City Council, Audit Subcommittee:

Assemblymember Gonzalez requested an audit of the Irvine City Council and its Audit Subcommittee.

*Motion to approve the audit by Jones, seconded by Baker: **Failed 9-3**, (Assembly 7-0, Senate 2-3).*

2015-111: High-Speed Rail Authority, Property Appraisals:

Senator Vidak requested an audit of the private property appraisal process used by the High-Speed Rail Authority and its contractors to acquire property for construction of the high-speed rail.

*Motion to approve the audit by Jones, seconded by Baker: **Failed 4-6**, (Assembly 3-3, Senate 1-3)*

2015-112: School Districts—Mental Health Funds and Services:

Senator Beall et al. requested an audit of mental health funds and services provided by school districts and special education local plan areas.

*Motion to approve the audit by Roth, seconded by Nazarian: **Approved 11-0**, (Assembly 6-0, Senate 5-0).*
